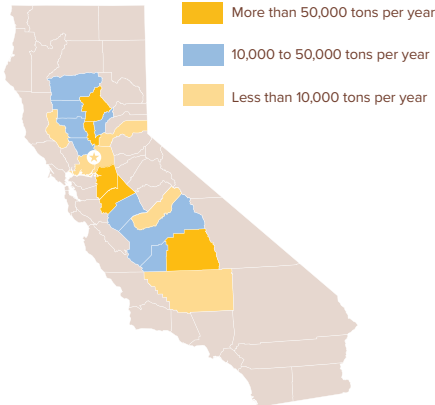

MEET TODD RAMOS

Todd Ramos has farming in his DNA. His grandfather, at the age of 12, traveled alone to California from Spain via Cuba in the early 1900s. He worked in various orchards and eventually married a young woman whose family had also come from Spain. As a young couple they purchased 10 acres of farmland, which grew into 300 acres of prune and walnut orchards during their 57-year marriage. Today it consists of 750 acres. The Ramos family legacy lives on as Todd and his father manage the farm with the same care and passion demonstrated by his grandparents.
